SECOND SCRIPTURE READING: 1 Corinthians 12:1-11

B rothers and sisters, I don't want there to be any misunderstanding concerning spiritual gifts. You know that when you were unbelievers, every time you were led to worship false gods you were worshiping gods who couldn't even speak. So I want you to know that no one speaking by God's Spirit says, "Jesus is cursed." No one can say, "Jesus is Lord," except by the Holy Spirit.

All you need is a small FM band radio with a 3.5 mm earplug/headphones jack, tuned to 87.9 FM. If you don't have one of these small cheap pocket radios, they are easily purchased where electronics are sold or online, like a: Personal FM AM Pocket Radio Portable, Mini Digital Tuning Stereo Walkman Radio with Rechargeable Battery, Earphone, LCD Display for Walking Jogging. Getting to Know Jesus ~ by Paul Schult

How can I get to know Jesus better? How can I possibly understand all that the Bible teachers and reveals? What is the most important teaching in the Bible for me to know?

The six core teachings in Martin's Luther's Small Catechism summarize the most critical truths of the Bible. However, the heart of the Bible is not just to know the right answers; it's to know Jesus.

Drawing on his personal experience as a pastor, the author unpacks six core teaching of the Bible in easy-to-understand relationship language. You will discover a deeper meaning in worship, prayer, Bible study, and personal devotions and be more deeply connected to Jesus. Plus, you'll be better prepared to talk to family and friends about your relationship with Jesus in a clear and personal way.

At the end of each chapter there are some personal reflection questions that you can use to dig a little deeper into the topic.
