We invite you to **PICK UP** a Lenten Series Packet from Bethany on **Transfiguration Sunday, February 14**th before or after on-campus worship, or from the Church Office during office hours (7:30AM-Noon) on **Monday, February 15**th or **Tuesday, February 16**th. These packets will have **items and information** we will use <u>each</u> Wednesday in our Mid-week worship.

For the Imposition of Ashes - there are TWO options to receive ashes on this day:

- 1. Included in the Lenten Series Packet will be a **Pre-Packaged Ash Kit** for your household to use **AT HOME** during our on-line, off campus, Ash Wednesday service; a drop of olive oil will be needed for the ashes.
- 2. For those who desire to receive the Imposition of Ashes IN PERSON, we are scheduling individual family unit Imposition of Ashes on campus earlier in the day on Wednesday, February 17th. Look for a Special Bethany Bullet on THURSDAY, FEBRUARY 11th on how to register for this. In-person timeframes are every 10 minutes from 6:00-8:30AM and 11:00AM-2:00PM. Those registered to attend the in-person timeframe will be ushered into the Narthex (a family unit at a time), and then enter into the Sanctuary. There will be a Confession on the screen that will be read together from the Communion rail area. The officiant will then use a Q-Tip to mark the back of the hand of each household member with an ashen cross and then the family will then exit the Sanctuary.
