FROM THE PRINCIPAL

Bethany Families,

Today we are sending home an Advent calendar with each student. We hope this interactive calendar will help your family prepare your hearts for the celebration of Jesus' birth!

The word "Advent" means "coming." During the season of Advent, we prepare for the coming of Jesus at Christmas. But that is not the *only* coming of Jesus that we hear about in the Advent story.

What is the rest of the Advent story? The Advent of Christ actually has three parts. God's Word tells us that Jesus not only came to earth as a man at Christmas, but that He comes to be with His church through His Word and Sacraments. Finally, God's Word reminds us that He will return on the Last Day...His "second coming."

There are other ways you can celebrate Advent in your home, as well.

- Some families have an Advent wreath with four candles (like the one we have in the church at Bethany.) The first week, one candle is lit, the next week two, etc.
- You are also invited to join a weekly Advent online Zoom gathering with other Bethany families on Wednesdays December 1, 8, 15 and 22 at 7:00 PM: <u>https://bit.ly/bethanyadvent</u> <u>2021</u> Password: Jesus!

For many years, the Schools of Bethany Lutheran have been working with Project Shepherd in Lakewood providing Christmas dinners and personal items to local families in need in the Long Beach & Lakewood area. Due to the strain on resources from the Covid-19 pandemic, their shelves are even more empty this year. You can help us help our neighbors by donating food items (see below) !

In addition to the below listed items, we also request a cash donation of **\$5/student** to purchase grocery scrip cards needed to purchase turkey/hams for each meal. Please place money in a small envelope and ensure it gets to your child's teacher. Thank you for your much-needed help!

Please have your child bring items no later than Tuesday, December 14, 2021

Kindergarten:	Baking/pancake mix (like Bisquick)	Pasta (any dry variety)
1 st grade:	Peanut Butter	Bars of Soap
2 nd grade:	Boxed Stuffing Mix	Spaghetti Sauce (no glass)
3 rd grade:	Jam/Jelly (no glass)	Boxed Stuffing mix
4 th grade:	Peanut Butter	Mac & Cheese
5 th grade:	Instant Potatoes	Canned meat (tuna or chicken)
6 th grade:	Baking/pancake mix (like Bisquick)	Potatoes (boxed/packets)
7 th grade:	Jam/Jelly (no glass)	Boxed Stuffing mix
8 th grade:	Cereal (box or bag)	Instant Potatoes

**Please <u>do not</u> purchase items in glass bottles or jars, as they can break- only plastic/boxes/cans. Avoid Costco sized items, remember BIGGER is not better, buy 2 small instead of one large. All items can be found at various local Dollar/99 Cent stores to keep things economical. Have your student participate in the shopping with you!

Want to do more ? Please feel free to bring in a larger cash donation so we can help more families. Also appreciated are other non-perishable pantry items like: Mayo, ketchup, mustard, cake/muffin mixes, canned fruits, sugar, instant oatmeal, etc. Or items for children like crayons, stickers or coloring books.
