



We felt the LOVE last week for Teacher Appreciation Week. I need to throw in my two cents about our wonderful teachers!


What do I appreciate?



We are in the second month of a new Scrip year (Rebate period is from April to March of the following year.) I wanted to take a moment to remind you that the minimum rebate amount has changed from \$2.50 to \$25. This means that you must earn at least \$25 in rebates in order for it to be applied to your tuition/ministry choice. This is easily accomplished with just a few purchases a year. Remember to use gift cards to make your purchases and not just use them as gifts. I personally have a reloadable grocery card that I use every time I shop. If it is running low on funds I can add money to it using the RaiseRight app while I'm shopping and it will be ready to use when I check out. I never miss out on an opportunity to earn while grocery shopping! That's just one example of how you can easily earn a great rebate. I have lots of ideas to help you do the same - just ask me how!
