

COVID Safety

If your student develops symptoms, please keep him/her at home. Obtain a COVID test kit (available in the school office) and test for COVID.

A student may return to school when:

- Symptoms have resolved and the student has been fever-free for 24 hours.
- The student has a negative COVID test after Day 5 OR it has been 10 days since symptom-onset.

If your student has been exposed to COVID, test on Day 1 and again on Day 5. If no symptoms develop and the student tests negative, he/she may continue to attend school.

FISH Hours

FISH stands for "Families Involved in Service Hours." Each Bethany family is required to give 5 hours of service each year. (Many of our families serve many more than 5 hours!) You can serve at events, drive for a trip/sport, bring in classroom supplies, assist your child's teacher and so much more.

You can log your FISH hours from the Bethany website OR from Gradelink. We'll send you a "FISHing Report" each quarter to let you know how many hours you've served.

Music Academy

Bethany's Music Academy provides extra-curricular music instruction to students in Grades 2-8 after school, M-F between 3:15 and 6:30 PM.

We have Christian instructors who are professionals in their field and offer lessons in piano (Grades 2 and up) and trumpet (4th grade and up.)

Tuition is \$300 per semester plus a \$25 registration fee which covers 12 lessons each semester.


