FROM THE PRINCIPAL

Here at Bethany we utilize Acadience and MAP assessments as one measure of students' academic achievement. These assessments are given three times during the school year: fall, winter and spring.

Our K-2 students have already started Acadience assessments in reading and math. These assessments are given oneon-one and help us determine if students are on track to experience success at their grade level and beyond. We also use the scores to determine the best placement for each students for instruction.

Our students in Grades 2-8 will begin MAP assessments in reading, math and language arts next week. These assessments serve the same purpose: are students on track for academic success? They also inform us about what students are ready to learn next.

Thank you for encouraging your student to do his/her best AND for avoiding outof-school appointments these next two weeks, if possible!

COVID Safety

If your student develops symptoms, please keep him/her at home. Obtain a COVID test kit (available in the school office) and test for COVID.

A student may return to school when:

- Symptoms have resolved and the student has been fever-free for 24 hours.
- The student has a negative COVID test after Day 5 OR it has been 10 days since symptom-onset.

If your student has been exposed to COVID, test on Day 1 and again on Day 5. If no symptoms develop and the student tests negative, he/she may continue to attend school.
