Looking for some Advent resources for your family?


Attached to this week's Bear Facts is an Advent calendar template and some suggested ways to use the calendar.

"The focus of Advent is two-fold. On the one hand, we prepare to celebrate the birth of Jesus Christ, the Son of God, who came into the world as both God and Man so that our sins might be forgiven. On the other hand, we anticipate the day when Jesus will return to Earth and bring an end to this world. Those will be scary days, but we can look forward to the end of the world with hope because through faith in Jesus, the end of this world will mean the beginning of a new life with Christ for eternity.

Advent, then, is a time for us to repent and believe. Knowing that Jesus was born to forgive our sins, we repent (admit our failures to God) and believe that we are forgiven because of the death and resurrection of Jesus on our behalf. Also, knowing that Jesus is coming back, we repent and believe that when He returns, He will give us eternal life." - Lutheran Hour Ministries





#### Ways to Use the Advent Calendar Template:

1- In a space or shape on the calendar, write the name of someone for whom you are praying. Doodle around the name or add color.

2- Read a daily Advent reflection, bible verse or meditation. Choose a word from the reading that jumps out at you. Write it in the shape and add a doodle or color.


3- Write and ponder an Advent word: prepare, wait, pregnant, hope, watch, darkness, longing, light... as you doodle and color.

4- Since Advent is a season of hope, write something you hope for each day. Offer that as a prayer to God as you draw, write or color.

5- For smaller children, just let them color. Consider placing a battery-powered votive candle near them to provide a quiet, calm place to work.

Visual prayer and faith calendar/colorings are not meant to be great works of art (although they are often beautiful). Enjoy the process as the words, marks and color end up creating a wonderful tapestry during this hopeful season.




